THE TREASURES CIRCLE

Some of the nation's leading philanthropists have become members of the Australian Museum Foundation's Treasures Circle, by pledging their support for one of the priceless treasures on display in the exhibition *200 Treasures of the Australian Museum*.

Each of the 100 cultural objects and scientific specimens on show in the Westpac Long Gallery can be supported with a commitment of \$30,000, which supports the display, conservation and maintenance of a treasure. Donors might also pledge \$50,000 to support a collection case on level one of the gallery, which contains specimens from each of the museum's collection areas, including anthropology, mammology and entomology.

The generous support of Treasures Circle members will be acknowledged with the treasure or case in the gallery and on the Australian Museum's Honour Board. Members will be invited to exclusive Treasures Circle events and programs.
